Keynote Speaker – Dr. Dan Undersander

Dr. Undersander is a professor of agronomy at the University of Wisconsin. He is an expert in the areas of forage production, grazing, hay, haylage, and silage making. He has been internationally recognized as an information source on forage production. He has authored more than 1,200 publications in the area of forage production and utilization and was responsible for the development of Relative Forage Quality.

Dr. Scott Barao

Dr. Barao, now retired from the University of Maryland, was a faculty member at the university for 20 years, serving as the state beef cattle extension specialist and beef program leader. He currently serves as the executive director of the Jorgensen Family Foundation and directs the day-to-day operation of Hedgeapple Farm. Additionally, he serves as executive vice president of the Maryland Cattlemen's Association and executive director of the Maryland Beef Council.

Dr. Douglas Beegle

Dr. Beegle, now retired from Penn State, is a distinguished professor emeritus of agronomy at the university. His areas of expertise include soil fertility, soil testing, nutrient management, and manure management. He is involved with extension education programs and is an advisor to state and federal government agencies and other organizations on nutrient management and agriculture-related water quality issues.

Andrew Frankenfield

Andrew Frankenfield is an agronomy extension educator at Penn State where he is leader for the Field and Forage Crops Team. His areas of expertise include field crops, forages, hay, and farm business management.

Dwight Lingenfelter

Dwight Lingenfelter is a Penn State Extension associate in weed science. In his position, he assists the state weed specialist with extension and applied research activities.

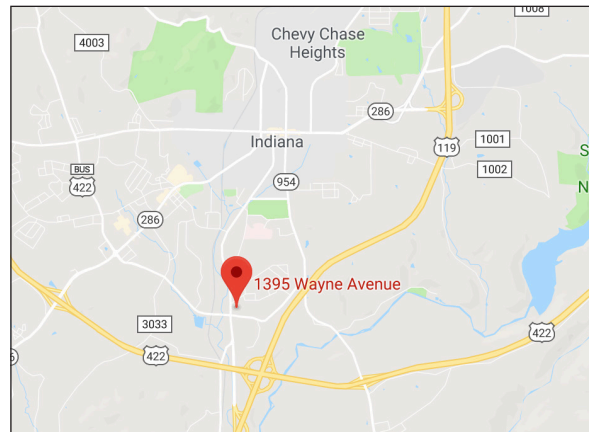

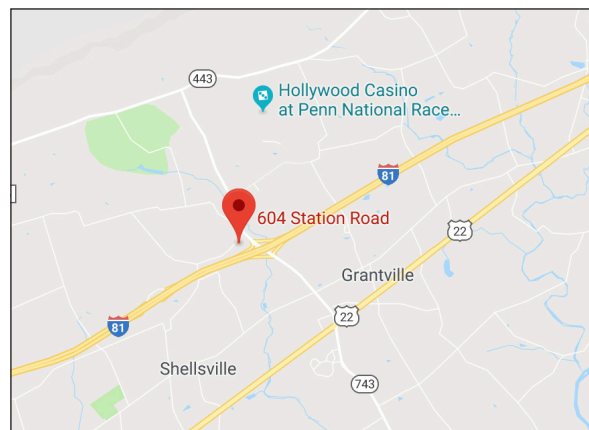
